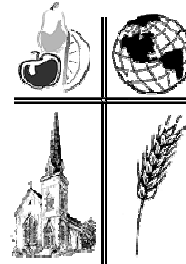

If the books do not arrive in time, we will not meet until August 31. Call Rob Scott for this or for other information at 964-7433.



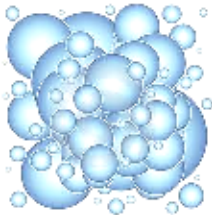
NEEDED FOR THE TUESDAY DEACON'S OUTREACH
