He has worked hard at numerous odd jobs over the years, but Al turned 67 on June 8th and though he has a small Supplemental Security Income, it provides food and clothing only. He is still able to do yard work and light cleanup, and is trustworthy, reliable, and hard working.

We pray that his future will be reasonably comfortable, sheltered from the elements, with appropriate work that will sustain him as he ages.
