Oklahoma. Representatives speaking today are Reverend Rick and Mrs. Sue Hahn. Rev. Hahn grew up in Hawaii and was raised in a military family residing on U.S. Air Force bases throughout the United States and the World. In 1966 he graduated from San José Bible College. Since then, Rick and his wife, Sue, have served in the mission field in Hawaii and the West Coast until retirement in 2010. For the past two years the Hahn's have been representing The Voice of the Martyrs here in Northern California.
