WOULD YOU LIKE A COPY EMAILED TO YOU OF "The Negative Feelings List" FROM LAST WEEKS SERMON?

In last week's semon, Pastor Bill McGuinness, spoke of STOP-ing to name and assess the particular negative feeling that knocked you off kilter (again) in one or more of the great many ways that our bodies/brains (and some subsystems) feel stressed/disstressed; and then the brain often transmits false, unhelpful, dysfunctional, or even sinful messages as to how deal with the negative feeling. Bill said that our body/brains are value-neutral so it is our souls rather than than merely brains that need to be in control. As Christians whose souls have been bonded with God's Spirit, we can overcome what comes merely naturally. By God's Spirit, we are not merely natural, but *super*natural beings! So, let's STOP to name what we are feeling, then LOOK deeply within to acknowledge the negativity of both the feeling and merely natural / habitual responses and then LISTEN for God's course correcting perspective through prayer, good counsel and scriptural principles /direction - all are great inputs in order to respond well. It's always helpful to be aware of the wide range of what we are dealing with, or might come up against in this beautiful but endangered and badly fallen world.
